





- Contractual issues




Average reduction in production over the year

What's happening here?

57% of our respondents indicated they had been reduced by 20% or more and 16% were more than 30%. 25% were under 20% while 18% had not had it reduced at all.

Business survival at an 80% production level for a year



What's happening here?


26% said YES they could survive for a year at 80% production while 29% said NO and 45% said MAYBE.


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Where will you be in 12 months?



What's happening here? For those that were asked where they would be in 12 months, 20% thought they'd have reduced crews, 21% thought reduced production, 33% would have full production while with the balance 4% departed and the rest were unsure. They would like to be positive but see themselves with reduced crews if nothing else.

What's happening here?


Costs have increased across the board, with median increases of wages being 6-10%, repairs and maintenance and insurance median being 11-15%, fuel and oil being the highest increases at a median of 16-20%.



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Status of current contracts held



What's happening here?

Most surveyed don't have long term contracts. 21% have not got a current contract at all, while 40% have a one-year contract and 17% have a two-year contract. Only 21% have 3-5yr contact.
